

Child having an asthma attack?





Any of these signs:

- Coughing
- Wheezing
- · Hard to breathe
- Tight chest
- Cannot walk
- Cannot talk

Do they need inhaler?

Remember: stay with the child at all times

Is this an emergency?



Intervene



- Keep calm
- Reassure child
- · Sit them up and slightly forward
- · Ask someone to get inhaler and spacer
- Administer inhaler (see Medicine steps)
- · Note time of using inhaler

Is this an



Medicine



- . Use blue inhaler
- Shake inhaler
- Place in spacer
- · Spray one puff
- · Take five breaths
- · Repeat the above up to 10 times if needed
- . If no improvement, it is safe to repeat the above 10 more times

Is this an



Emergency



- If no improvement, or if you are worried or unsure, call 999
- If ambulance takes longer than 15 mins. repeat Medicine steps
- Note time of calling 999
